GENERAL SUMMARY:

Under general supervision of the Manager Distribution, Working Foreman or Lead Lineman, perform any and all duties related to the construction, maintenance and repair of electrical overhead and underground distribution system.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS*:

- Receive work assignments; obtain necessary stock, tools and equipment and prepare materials to accomplish projects.
- Oversee and participate in a variety of construction, maintenance, and repair activities to overhead and underground secondary power systems. Assist 1st class lineman on primary voltage lines. Erect wood and steel poles, run and sag line wire and connect single and three phase transformer banks. Install underground conductors, conduit and related apparatus.
- Operate and work from digger/derrick and bucket trucks and utilize a variety of hand and power tools and testing equipment in support of line construction, maintenance and repair operations.
- Climb poles.
- Maintain and repair/replace street lighting and supporting structures.
- Assist in maintenance of vehicles, buildings and grounds, and operating equipment.
- Accept stand-by call on a rotating basis and respond to Department emergencies.

OTHER DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- May operate diesel engine and stations as required.
- Attend safety meetings.
- Performs any other duties as required.

PREPARATION, KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES:

- Duties require high school or trade school education and up to 3 years of progressively responsible related experience.
- Regularly uses hand and power tools requiring eye-hand coordination and finger dexterity.
- Commonwealth of Massachusetts Commercial drivers license required.
- Ability to communicate and to interact effectively with others.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITY:

No direct supervision

WORKING CONDITIONS/PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

- Regular time spent outside subject to adverse weather conditions while inspecting or completing work.
- Exposure to voltage ranging from 120 to 480 independently and 2,400 to 23,000 with supervision.
- Frequent walking, standing, climbing, lifting and occasional requirement for sustained uncomfortable physical positions.
- Regularly lifts and moves 50 – 80 pounds; 100+ pounds with assistance.
- Exposed to various fumes, solvents, fuels, and gases.
