

Light Commission June 6, 2025 meeting

Minutes of the Open Session and the Executive Session

A quorum being present, Chair Yarmoff brought the meeting to order at 8:20 am. The meeting was held with all members participating via remote internet access. Comments from the Public

There were no participants from the public, whether in person or remote.

Executive Session

Chair Yarmoff declared that an open session would have detrimental effect in obtaining qualified applicants for the position of MMLD General Manager. He requested a motion to enter Executive Session to consider or interview applicants for employment or appointment by the Screening Committee of the Light Commission, not to return to open session.

The motion was moved by Commissioner Yarmoff, seconded by Commissioner Frechette.

He also reminded the participants that since this session was held remotely, it was the responsibility of all participants to make sure that they were in a location where they could not be overheard, and that any vote that the group takes must be by roll call. Commissioner Yarmoff then left the meeting.

The Executive Session started at 8:23 am, with Commissioners Frechette and Smith and the other members of the Selection Subcommittee of the Light Commission, Alexa Singer, Select Board Member; Tom Howard, Marblehead HR Director; Greg Chane, MMLD Distribution Manager all participating remotely in Zoom meetings that were organized with three candidates. Questions had been prepared in advance and the same questions were asked of all the candidates during one-hour interviews.

The Executive Session concluded at noon at which point a motion to adjourn was proposed, seconded and, after a roll call of the Subcommittee members voting unanimously in favor, adopted.

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
